Trauma Focused Therapy (TFT) uses a range of techniques to help the child or teen cope with the difficult feelings experienced by a trauma. The principals are exposure, cognitive restructuring and coping skills for emotional and physical adjustment to their experiences.

Alexander Youth Network AYN offers the following Evidence-Based Treatments in Cabarrus County: Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR), Multi-systemic Therapy, Multisystemic Therapy – Problem Sexual Behavior, Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics (NMT), and Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy.

Nazareth Child and Family Connection Nazareth Child and Family Connection provides Trauma Focused Level II Residential Services, Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and Assessments, Substance Abuse Treatment, and the Focus program. The Focus Program uses the Sanctuary Model and is designed for children who have been removed from family and placed in the state's care for an indefinite period of time. These children are likely to have been removed from their homes as a result of emotional, physical or sexual abuse or neglect. These children have experienced some form of trauma. The Sanctuary Model recognizes that "hurt people hurt people" and that therefore, creating and sustaining a just environment is vital to everyone's safety and well-being.

All are trauma focused and/or informed EBP modalities.
