## Family Engagement Activities minimum requirements:

- 1. Parent conferences- Minimum of 2 per year.
- 2. Parent Training/Education- **Minimum of 2 per year**. This number can include the Transition to Kindergarten workshop. Other suggestions for parent education include Triple P/ behavior information, school/home routines, financial literacy and family nutrition. Sites are not limited to the topics on this list.
- 3. Transition into Pre-K- **At least 1 home visit or parent meeting before child starts school**. While not all parents are open to home visits, but may be willing to meet at the school or another public place. Open house or orientation time for families and staggered entry days are mandatory for all sites.
- 4. Transition out of Pre-K- A parent education meeting on the topic of Transition to Kindergarten must be provided to parents, plus at least one item from the list of activities in the Transition Plan.
- 5. Classroom visits and options for parents to participate in class- **Minimum of 4 per year**. Some ideas for activities include family projects at home, file folder game night, parent volunteers in the classroom and on field trips, parent/child activity days, etc.
